

Construction Industry Master Workshop 2025  
SAFETY REGULATIONS

By registering, purchasing a ticket, or entering the premises of the Construction Industry Master Workshop, the Visitor explicitly accepts the rules related to visiting the Construction Industry Master Workshop.

These Safety Regulations apply not only to Visitors but also to anyone entering the Workshop area for any other reason (hereinafter collectively: Visitor).

By entering the hall designated for the Construction Industry Master Workshop or any related work area, the Visitor explicitly acknowledges that dangerous machinery, equipment, and materials are used as part of the event. Additionally, strong noise, contaminants (e.g., dust, vapor, sparks, etc.), and other effects may be present.

For the purpose of health and accident prevention, the Visitor is obliged to follow all necessary or otherwise reasonable safety instructions and to behave in a generally expected manner, especially considering the increased risk of accidents.

The Visitor must follow the instructions and directives of the site operator during the event and fully comply with all rules that protect their own and others' physical safety.

Within the work area, machinery, equipment, or materials may only be touched or used with the express permission and guidance of the site operator.

Due to the increased risk of accidents, the consumption of alcoholic beverages is strictly prohibited on the premises, and it is forbidden to attend the event under the influence of alcohol, drugs, or any other intoxicating substances.

Minors may only enter the Construction Industry Master Workshop under the supervision of an adult. The Visitor is responsible for ensuring that any minor or other person or animal under their supervision or accompaniment fully complies with the above rules. The organizer reserves the right to deny entry to unaccompanied minors and may request proof of age by checking a valid ID. However, the organizer is not responsible for verifying the age of individuals entering the event.

Before entering, each Visitor must sign a written Liability Waiver, declaring they have read and accepted the safety and visitor rules and guidelines. In the case of minors, the Liability Waiver must be signed by an adult exercising parental authority.

The personal data provided will be processed solely for the purpose of proving liability acceptance and will not be used for any other purposes.

Visitors are fully responsible for any injuries or damages resulting from failure to comply with these rules.

The event organizer is not liable for any damages arising from violations of the above rules.
